

Authorisation to Mumbai Metro Rail Corporation Limited (MMRCL) to undertake heavy engineering, infrastructure, consultancy and turnkey works within India and abroad.

Introduction:

Mumbai Metro Rail Corporation Limited (MMRCL), having its registered office at Transit Office Building, E-Block, Bandra-Kurla Complex (BKC), Bandra (East), Mumbai – 400051, is a Joint Venture Company of the Government of India and the Government of Maharashtra, each holding 50% equity, incorporated under the Companies Act, 1956;

MMRCL has successfully completed the design, construction, testing and commissioning of the Aqua Line (Mumbai Metro Line-3), a 33.5 km fully underground metro rail project in Mumbai, at a total project cost of INR 372.76 billion (approximately USD 4.5 billion), comprising 26 underground stations, one at-grade station and one car depot;

MMRCL has further been entrusted with the implementation of another underground metro corridor of approximately 17.50 km length (Line-11) in Mumbai at an estimated cost of approximately INR 235.00 billion (USD 2.8 billion), and is also executing various construction projects including high-rise buildings for rehabilitation of project-affected persons, and shall also be undertaking construction of long underground public vestibules totalling approximately 43.0 km;

The Government considers it expedient to leverage the technical expertise, institutional capability and experience of MMRCL in the field of complex infrastructure development;

Hence, the Government of Maharashtra hereby resolves as follows:

02. Government Resolution:

1. Mumbai Metro Rail Corporation Limited (MMRCL) is hereby authorised to undertake and execute, either directly or through appropriate contractual arrangements:
 - a) Heavy civil and infrastructure works, including but not limited to construction of tunnels, caverns, underground structures, stations, depots, bridges, viaducts and other major infrastructure works;
 - b) Consultancy assignments, including but not limited to metro rail, urban transport and infrastructure projects;
 - c) Turnkey/EPC/D&B projects and other allied and complementary works in the fields of infrastructure development and urban transport.

2. The above authorisation shall be valid for execution of such works within India and/or abroad, without any monetary or scope limitation.
3. This authorisation is issued in public interest and with the approval of the competent authority.
4. This Government Resolution will not impose any financial burden on the state government.
